Apparently, Spirit showed Carl these events in his life, as a vision, which he wrote down.*

The little boy would talk to all the adults and tell them things that no child could possibly know. The owner of the house never asked any money for rent for the house, and farm and would never visited the place as long as the family lived there with the little boy."
