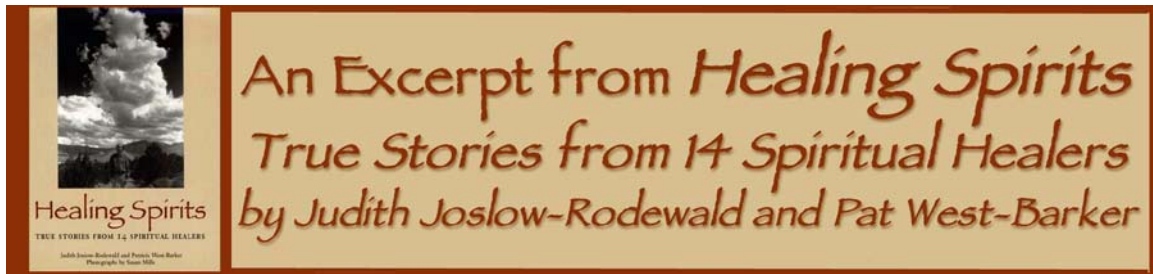


## *Carl's First Encounter With Awan*
