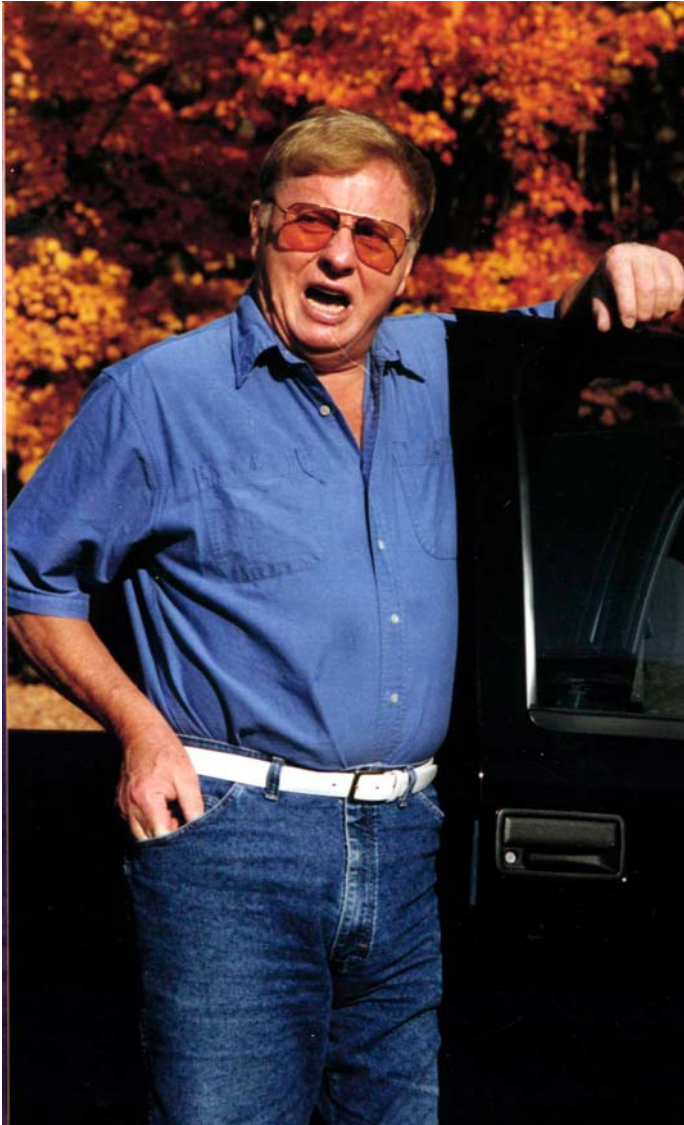


Please Take It Away
